God is our firm foundation!

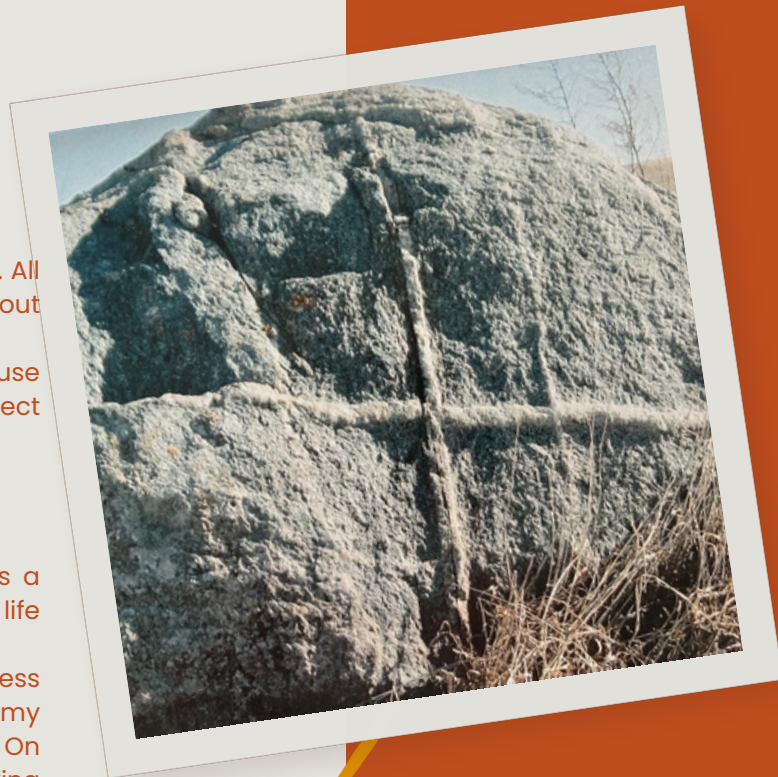
God is strong!

Imagine more joy. John 20:1-18

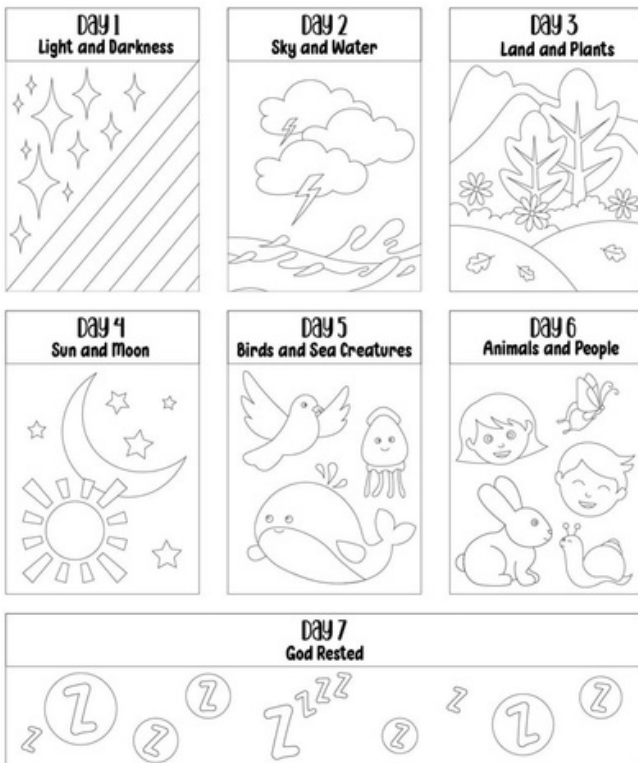

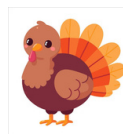

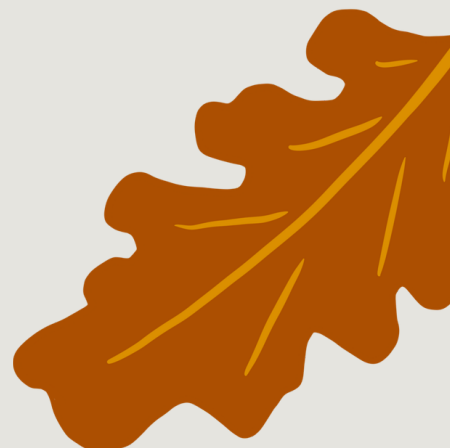
